
Scissor Work

How to hold scissors







Order of scissor cutting skills

- Opening and closing without paper
 - If not able to do with ease- keep practicing and continue tong work, clothes pin work, and working with clay. Any work that helps strengthen the wrist, hand, and fingers is helpful.
- Snippets thin strips of paper without lines that cut with one open and close the strip of paper.
- Strips with lines over time getting closer and closer to cutting on the line.
 - Any eye to hand coordination work will help.
- Wider strips of paper with lines
 - requires multiple open and close with scissors.
- As accuracy improves strips become longer
- Lines on the diagonal
- Lines that zigzag
- Curves or wavy lines
- Circles that get larger in diameter
- Squares and rectangles
- Complex shapes heart shapes, flowers, etc.

It is important to note that the hand holding the paper should be moved/ turned not the hand holding the scissors.
