This is continuing the previous weeks' downward trends. The John Hopkins Coronavirus Resource Center (<a href="https://coronavirus.jhu.edu/data/new-cases-50-states/arizona">https://coronavirus.jhu.edu/data/new-cases-50-states/arizona</a>) is showing Arizona as green with a 64% drop in cases. This data continues to trend in the direction that we want.
