

Subject: Test Results for COVID-19 Negative

Dear Khalsa Community,

The saliva test results have been received from the testing on the primary campus last Tuesday. Everyone was negative for COVID-19. Every family who chose to test elsewhere has been confirmed as negative, too.

The school chose to take a proactive stance and moved quickly to ascertain the COVID-19 status of the classroom students and staff. All staff and students have received negative COVID-19 test results. The 14 day quarantine period is now over. The positive staff person will have two negative COVID-19 PCR tests before returning to work.

We will continue to follow the practices outlined in our KMS Fall Operating Plan: wearing masks by all staff and appropriately aged students, washing hands or using hand sanitizer, regular cleaning of all spaces and materials used, sick students or staff to stay home and healthy distancing among students and staff. These procedures are best practices against the spread of the virus.

Finally, the choices that each of us makes, whether at school or home, determines our personal safety and that of the whole group. This experience is a reminder that what we choose to do matters. We can make a commitment to uphold The Promise and hold our families, school, and community as both precious and special.
