Upper Elementary Student Supply List 2024 - 2025 School Year

Students attending the UE summer orientation should bring these items on their first day; all other students should bring items on the second day of school.

Note: These items will be in a collective pool to be used throughout the year. Please do not label these with student names.

- 1 package of colored pencils (12 colors)
- 1 12" translucent, acrylic office ruler with inches and centimeters
- 1 pair of dishwashing gloves
- 1 pair of soft-grip, straight-handled 7" scissors
- 1 multi-pack of glue sticks (4 qty.+)
- 1 package of Pentel hi-polymer erasers (2-pack)
- 1 journal for artwork
- 1 box or package of Ticonderoga-brand pencils (this is the *only* pencil brand we use)
- 1 plastic box for index cards (if needed returning students may already have one)
- 2 pencil sharpeners
- 2 two-pocket folders, poly-material, no hole fasteners
- 2 packages of notecards
- 3 college-ruled spiral notebooks (for language work)
- 3 spiral notebooks with 4-square-per-inch grid paper (for math and geometry work)
- 4 composition, college-ruled notebooks (approximately 100 pages each)

Miscellaneous items requested by grade level:

- First-year students: 2 containers of disinfectant wipes (any brand is okay)
- Second-year students: 1 bottle of dishwashing soap (any brand is okay)
- Final-year students: 1 feather or microfiber duster

Required Items for students' personal use:

- 1 1"three-ring binder with pockets (for homework)
- 1 pencil pouch or pencil box
- 2 tri-fold display boards (to be used for special projects; these can be purchased at the start of each project)
- A Phoenix public library card in the child's name
- All first-year students need an analog watch to build their time-telling skills that they will wear to school every day (no digital or smart watches, please)

In Upper Elementary, all students use a backpack to transport their belongings. Each student also needs an insulated lunchbox (we do not have cooled storage) with ice packs, as well as a reusable water bottle with a strap. (When on field trips, students need to be "hands-free".)

To help students complete their homework assignments, students need the following items <u>at home</u>:

- College-ruled notebook filler paper
- 4-square per inch graph paper
- Drawing compass or circle template
- Small, plastic protractor
- Acrylic office ruler with inches and centimeters
- Pencils regular and red for editing
- Dictionary
- Thesaurus
